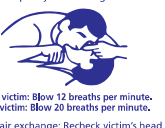


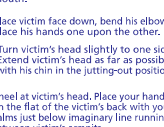

IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARDS

- Failure to provide adequate supervision and required staffing
- Failure to provide required disinfection levels
- Failure to treat and achieve proper disinfection following contamination event
- Failure to maintain pH levels between 6.5 and 8.0
- Failure to maintain Cyanuric Acid levels below 100 PPM
- Use of an unapproved water supply source for potable water observed
- Absence of all required lifesaving equipment on deck observed
- Failure to maintain GFCI protection for underwater lighting as required
- Aquatic venue bottom not visible
- Total absence or improper marking of depth observed
- Plumbing cross-connections between drinking water and waste water observed
- Failure to maintain an enclosure or barrier to prevent unauthorized access to aquatic venue
- Use of unapproved chemicals or application by unapproved methods
- Broken, unsecured, or missing suction outlet covers observed
- Broken glass or sharp objects in the venue or on deck observed

MOUTH-TO-MOUTH MOUTH-TO-NOSE	CHEST PRESSURE-ARM LIFT (SILVERSTER)	BACK PRESSURE-ARM LIFT (HOLGEER-NIELSON)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove foreign matter from victim's mouth. • Tilt victim's head back, chin pointing upward. Pull or push jaw into jutting-out position. • Open your mouth wide and place over victim's mouth. Pinch victim's nostrils shut. OR • Close victim's mouth. Place your mouth over victim's nose. Blow into victim's mouth or nose. • Remove your mouth and turn head to one side. Listen for victim's return rush of air. Repeat your blowing effort.   <p>Adult victim: Blow 12 breaths per minute. Child victim: Blow 20 breaths per minute.</p> <p>If no air exchange: Recheck victim's head and jaw position. If still no air exchange, turn victim on side and deliver several sharp blows between his shoulder blades.</p> <p>Recheck victim's mouth for foreign matter.</p> <p>If direct contact with victim is undesirable, lace cloth over victim's mouth or nose before making blowing effort.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove foreign matter from victim's mouth. • Lay victim flat, face up. Prop shoulders to raise them and allow head to drop back. • Kneel at victim's head. Grasp victim's arms at his wrists, cross them and press firmly over his lower chest, forcing air from the lungs. • Immediately release pressure. Pull victim's arms outward and upward and backward as far as possible over his head, forcing air into the lungs.   <p>Repeat cycle 12 times per minute. Check mouth frequently for obstructions.</p> <p>Keep victim's head extended and turned to one side. If second rescuer is available, they should hold victim's head with jaw in jutting-out position.</p> <p>KEEP VICTIM WARM UNTIL MEDICAL AID ARRIVES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove foreign matter from victim's mouth. • Place victim face down, bend his elbows, place his hands one upon the other. • Turn victim's head slightly to one side. Extend victim's head as far as possible with his chin in the jutting-out position. • Kneel at victim's head. Place your hands on the flat of the victim's back with your palms just below imaginary line running between victim's armpits. • Rock forward on your arms until they are vertical, allowing your upper body weight to exert steady pressure upon your hands.   <p>Immediately draw victim's arms upward and toward you until you feel resistance and tension at shoulders. Lower victim's arms to the ground.</p> <p>Repeat this cycle 12 times per minute. Check victim's mouth frequently for obstruction.</p>

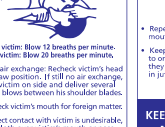


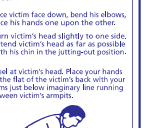

- DO NOT SWALLOW OR SPIT SPA WATER
- MAXIMUM SPA TEMPERATURE 104° F
- INTENTIONAL HYPERVENTILATION OR EXTENDED BREATH HOLDING ACTIVITIES ARE DANGEROUS AND PROHIBITED.
- ALL PERSONS USING SPA DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK, OWNERS AND MANAGEMENT NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS OR INJURY.
- SPA FOR RESIDENT USE ONLY. ALL GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY RESIDENT. NO SOLO BATHING ALLOWED.
- PROPER BATHING ATTIRE MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.
- NO RUNNING, JUMPING, PUSHING, OR DIVING.
- NO FOOD, GLASS CONTAINERS OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN SPA AREA.
- PLEASE REPORT ANY CONDITION IN THE SPA AREA THAT NEEDS ATTENTION TO THE RESIDENT SERVICES CENTER.
- EXTENDED EXPOSURE TO THE HOT WATER OR VAPORS MAY BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE HEALTH OF ELDERLY PERSONS AND PERSONS WITH HEART CONDITIONS, DIABETES, OR HIGH OR LOW BLOOD PRESSURE.
